PRESS NOTE

Sub: Use of Loudspeakers for election campaign.

As per the directions of Election Commission: *q India*

- 1) All political parties, candidates and any other person using any loud speakers on moving vehicles including but not restricted to trucks, tempos, car, taxis, vans, three wheelers, scooters, cycles rickshaws, etc. shall intimate the registration identification number of those vehicles to the authorities granting permission to use the loudspeakers and such registration identification numbers of the vehicles shall be indicated on the permits granted by the authorities concerned.
- 2) Any vehicles on which a loud speaker is used without the said written permit shall be confiscated alongwith the loudspeaker and all the apparatus used alongwith it.
- 3) No loudspeaker fitted on vehicles of any kind or in any other manner whatsoever shall be permitted to be used during the period of 48 hours ending with the hour fixed for the conclusion of the poll in any polling area.
