

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 26.07.2019 AT 1700 HRS UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER, ANDAMAN & NICOBAR ISLANDS TO DISCUSS THE SCHEDULE AND ACTIVITIES OF SPECIAL SUMMARY REVISION OF PHOTO ELECTORAL ROLLS W.R.T 01.01.2020 AS QUALIFYING DATE

DEO South Andaman did not attend the meeting.

At the onset of the meeting, the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), Andaman & Nicobar Island has informed about the schedule and activities to be carried out on Special Summary Revision (SSR) of Photo Electoral Rolls w.r.t 01.01.2020 as the qualifying date.

Following directions has been given to all District Election Officers (DEOs) / Electoral Registration Officer (ERO):-

1. A training programme should be conducted in first week of August to build the capacity of BLO/Supervisor to carry out the task in hand
[Action By: All DEO's]
2. The schedule of SSR should be published in print/electronic media and also on social media to disseminate information on Special Summary Revision of Electoral Roll activities. The various verification tools such as Voter's Helpline 1950, Voter's Mobile App, National Voters Service Portal (NVSP), Common Service Centres (CSCs) be also be published so that the voters can verify their details through these facilities. Contact details of BLOs/AEROs/ ERO should be published so that electors can directly contact these officials for help and assistance. Intensive discussions with electors should be carried out through House to House (H2H) survey and also crowd sourcing to verify and collect details of un-enrolled citizens/dead/shifted electors etc.

3. It was directed that the detail instructions issued by the Commission should be provided to all the field level officials through dak and also during the course of training so that it will work as reference book for field level officer's while implementing the programme of SSR.
[Action By: All DEO's/ERO]
4. It was also directed that all the supervisory officials such as Supervisor/AEROs/ERO/Deputy CEO/DEO's/CEO should undertake extensive field visit to verify the % of voters in electoral rolls as per the prescribed % given in the instructions. A copy/report be sent to CEO's Office for onward submission to Commission.
[Action By: All Concerned Officials]

5. Due diligence should be maintained while implementing SSR by all the officials and if there, any bonafide laxity is observed from the field level officials immediate action should be taken but not later than seven (07) days from the day the laxity came into notice.

[Action By: All DEO's/ERO]

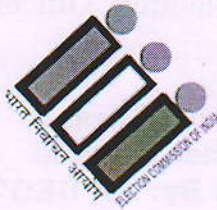
6. The detail of PwD electors so identified with the help of Social Welfare Department should be weekly intimated to the office of the Chief Electoral Officer for onward submission to Commission.

7. It was also directed that rationalization of Polling Stations should be done as per the schedule and submit details to the CEO, ANI for obtaining approval from the Commission.

8. It was decided that Roll Observer, Deputy CEO & CEO will visit Districts in 02nd week of August to ascertain the progress done by the Districts as per the schedule of SSR notified.
