

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 01<sup>ST</sup> AUGUST, 2019 AT 04:00 PM UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF CHIEF ELECTORAL OFFICER, A & N ISLANDS WITH LOCAL REPRESENTATIVES OF ALL RECOGNIZED POLITICAL PARTIES AND ALL ELECTORAL RELATED OFFICIALS REGARDING ACTIVITIES OF SPECIAL SUMMARY REVISION OF PHOTO ELECTORAL ROLLS W.R.T. 01.01.2020, AS THE QUALIFYING DATE.**

1. At the onset of the meeting, the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), A & N Islands has informed about the schedule and activities to be carried out on Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Roll w.r.t. 01.01.2020, as the qualifying date and requested the representatives of political parties to co-operate in enrolment of eligible un-enrolled electors, correction, deletions, shifting of electors and preparation of error free electoral roll of this Parliamentary Constituency. He also requested them to extend their co-ordination in achievement of 100% healthy roll by giving wide publicity through their BLAs about the program and importance of right to voting and empowerment etc.

2. Joint CEO and ERO, ANIPC have also been directed to give wide publicity of the roll schedule through print as well as electronic media so that general public will aware of the programme and voter can verify their details through the facilities of Voter's Helpline 1950, Voter's Mobile App, National Voters Service Portal (NVSP) etc.

3. All representatives of political parties have been informed that all instructions being issued time to time by the Election Commission of India, New Delhi in respect of SSR – 2020 will be made available to them for information and necessary action.

4. Further, they were also requested to appoint Booth Level Agents (BLAs) for each polling booth/station who will help Booth Level Officers (BLOs) for verification of details of electors and receiving claims and objections, and sought for their cooperation in the roll revision exercise so that we could able to achieve the target/moto of Commission **"No Voter to be left behind"**. A list of BLA be submitted by all Political Parties to this office for further action.

5. ERO/All AEROs are directed to update the lists by appointing sufficient number of BLOs and ensure that all BLOs are in place at their respective Polling Stations during the exercise of SSR-2020 without delay. Simultaneously, it was also directed that all activities as per the time line should be scrupulously followed up. A compliance report in this regard should be sent to this office regularly for onward submission to the Election Commission of India.

6. A wide publicity through an effective SVEEP campaigns like nukkad natak, publicizing of press note via print media, distribution of pamphlets, display of street banners, rally, marathon etc. shall be organized to all citizens encouraging them to come forward and authenticate existing elector's details relating thereto. A plan of action shall be prepared for organizing these campaigns effectively. A special Electors Verification Programme (EVP) may also be launched at all tehsils level during the pre-revision period before the actual start of Summary Revision of 2020 may campaign mode to the help of SVEEP.

7. Necessary capacity building training to BLOs may be conducted before the commencement of the revision exercise so that all BLOs would be well versed about the activities and norms etc. in respect of SSR-2020. After voters verification programme ensure House to House (H2H) Survey as per the schedule provided in the instructions.

8. It was directed that 1950 Helpline be made operational during working hours to facilitate verification of elector's detail by the electors. It is also informed that the general public can file their claims & objections through online by log on to ECI's website <http://www.nvsp.in>.

9. Rationalization of Polling Stations including standardization of the sections and address as per the latest instructions should be made thoroughly and regularization of auxiliary polling stations created during General Election to Lok Sabha, 2019. The help and cooperation is needed from political parties on this issue also.
